Macy/Randall Island**

On **Monday, November 6, 2017, at 6:30 p.m.** the City of La Habra City Council will hold a meeting to consider the following items:

Consideration of resolutions requesting the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) approve the annexation of County Islands known as the Macy/Randall Island, Citrus/Idaho Island, Citrus/Entrada Island, Cypress/Terry Island, Hensel/Magda Island and Palm/Shadycrest Island to the City of La Habra and a Property Tax Exchange Agreement and Annexation, Dissolution of County Service Area #20 and transfer of Drainage Facilities between the City of La Habra and the County of Orange.

Our records show that you own property within the Macy/Randall Island. You are invited to attend the meeting and express your views about the proposed action. The meeting will be held in the City of La Habra, Council Chambers, at 100 East La Habra Boulevard.
