La Habra Police Department Citizens' Police Academy

What is the Citizens' Academy?

The La Habra Police Department is proud to offer the Citizens' Police Academy to local residents. The Citizens' Academy is not designed to prepare students to be police officers, instead it was developed to create a closer working relationship between the police department and those who live and/or work in the community.

The Academy is taught by personnel from all areas of the agency, and consists of regularly scheduled evening classes held one night weekly, over a 6 week period. During that time, participants enjoy a variety of experiences, including a police facility tour, S.W.A.T. and K-9 demonstrations, crime scene investigative techniques, problem solving scenarios, and much more.

The goal of the Citizens' Police Academy is to increase understanding between community members and the Police Department, and to further enhance the strong relationship, which already exists.

A graduation ceremony is held at the conclusion of the training. Attendees are afforded an opportunity to go on a ride along with an officer after the completion of the Academy.



Who is eligible to attend?

- ◆ *Must be resident, property owner, or work in the City of La Habra*
- ◆ *Must be 18 years of age or older*
- ◆ *NO felony or serious misdemeanor arrests or convictions*
- ◆ *No outstanding warrants or pending criminal cases*
- ◆ *Have a good driving record*
- ◆ *Successfully pass background check*

How do I register?

Interested residents and business owners must complete and return the attached application to the La Habra Police Department, 150 N. Euclid Street, La Habra, CA 90631, along with a photocopy of a current valid government issued photo ID card.

Class size is limited to 24 students per session, so those wishing to participate, should return their applications, as soon as possible, to ensure attendance. Anyone not selected to attend the Citizens' Police Academy, due to space availability, will be placed on a waiting list for future Academy classes.
